Internship opportunity

Overview

Clinical research interns support the Critical Care Research Center at Regions Hospital and Methodist Hospital in clinical trials. Areas include:

- Adult and Pediatric Level I Trauma Program
- Burn Center
- Cardiology
- Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT)
- Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
- Emergency Medicine
- Medical Intensive Care
- Plastic Surgery
- Surgery Hospital Medicine
- Surgical Intensive Care

Interns will work in the Emergency Department for most of their shifts and will attend codes (traumas, strokes and cardiac arrests) to screen patients for studies.

Key duties

- Data collection and abstraction
- Screen patients for studies
- Support patient enrollments into clinical studies
- Engage with medical personnel to confirm eligibility
- Coordinate drug delivery and lab draws with nursing staff

Ideal candidates

- Are interested in a career in medicine, health sciences, or clinical research
- Have previous research and/or patient care experience

Shift hours

- Weekdays and weekends
- Day shifts (8 a.m. to 4 p.m.)
- Evening shifts (4 p.m. to midnight)
- Overnight shifts (midnight to 8 a.m.)

Availability requirements

This is a 12-month, paid research experience that begins in June each year. This is not a summer internship. New interns must be available for training in early June.
